2013 Holden Evening Prayer Lenten Schedule

Each Wednesday during Lent St. Matthew invites the community to join us at **6 PM** in our Fellowship Hall for a “**Meager Meal**” of soup and sandwiches.

Following the meal, we will gather upstairs in our sanctuary at **7 PM** for **Holden Evening Prayer**, a beautiful service that combines the timeless scripture and prayers of the traditional evening prayer liturgy with melodious contemporary music that will joyfully echo in your ears long after you have departed.

Our Holden Evening Prayer service runs just 45 minutes in length, and includes Holy Communion by intinction. We also take a few minutes to spotlight the life of a different Christian in history whose life pointed to Christ and who can serve as a model of faithful discipleship for us. This year, we will focus on six “unsung heroes” of the Lutheran faith, three of whom lived in the 20th century:
