

## WEDNESDAYS IN LENT AT ST. MATTHEW LUTHERAN CHURCH



On Wednesday evenings in Lent, we here at St. Matthew we will gather once again for a “meager meal” (usually soup and sandwiches) followed by Holden Evening Prayer. Dinner will begin at 5:30 pm and Evening Prayer will start at 6:30 pm. This will get folks to the church a little earlier in the evening and allow our choir rehearsal to end at its customary time of 7:30 pm.

During those Wednesday evening services Pastor Scott will be presenting a series of homilies on the theme of “**The Forgotten Psalms.**” Each evening will spotlight a Psalm that does not appear in our three-year cycle of Sunday readings. On most of those Wednesday evenings we will celebrate Holy Communion, but (as noted below) on two Wednesdays we will instead come to the communion rail for an anointing and blessing as part of a healing service. **Here is our 2014 schedule:**
